

Statement on Endocrine Disruptors

The French Law on Anti-Waste and Circular Economy “LOI n° 2020-105 du 10 février 2020“, also known as AGECE law, mandates that manufacturers of consumer products containing proven, presumed, or suspected endocrine disruptors must provide the necessary information for the public to electronically identify these substances in the products.

The ‘Arrêté du 28 septembre 2023’ establishes the official list of substances with endocrine disrupting properties. Currently, the published list contains – with two exceptions – only substances which are also regulated under Article 59, paragraph 10 of REACH Regulation n° 1907/2006 (Candidate List of substances of very high concern, SVHC substances). The two substances which are not listed as SVHC (Mancozeb CAS 8018-07-7 and Cholécalférol 67-97-0) are not commonly used in the manufacture of our packaging materials.

We hereby confirm that endocrine disruptors as set out in the ‘Arrêté du 28 septembre 2023’ are not present in the packaging materials currently produced by our raw material supplier and which are delivered to your company in amounts above 0.1% by mass. This confirmation is based on current raw material data information and our knowledge of manufacturing processes. The information is given in good faith and to the best of our current knowledge.
